

# Signature Level 2 Award in British Sign Language



## Overview

Signature Level 2 Award in British Sign Language is an accredited qualification (QCF). The qualification is designed to enable learners to develop an ability to communicate with Deaf people using BSL in a range of familiar contexts, participating in longer and more open-ended exchanges than at Level 1. The course will develop functional communication in BSL about a range of real life, routine and daily experiences. The learner will be able to deal with most routine language tasks and have sufficient grasp of grammar to cope with some non-routine tasks.



## Who should come on the course?

HearFirst only provide this course as an in house course i.e. for organisations who wish to book a cohort of people onto a course delivered at their organisation. It's suitable for people who have passed Level 1 BSL and:

- Work with a colleague who is a BSL User.
- Meet BSL users in their work.
